5-night driving safari in Kenya

AMBOSELI • LAKE NAIVASHA • MASAI MARA

A short itinerary packed with interest providing an exciting overview of Kenya and her wildlife. There are no age restrictions for children at the lodges, which makes this an ideal choice for families. Exclusive buses for sole use of families are available at a reasonable supplement.

Amboseli is home to an abundance of mammals and over 400 species of birds. Plains game, lions, cheetahs and vast herds of elephants wander freely. The area is dominated by the stunning spectacle of Mount Kilimanjaro. At Lake Naivasha there is plenty for all the family to do. Not only can you go horse riding or cycling, but the main attraction is the 450 species of birds which have been recorded in and around this freshwater lake.

Finally into the world-famous Masai Mara, one of the world's most enthralling wildlife theatres. The reserve plays host to countless species, including the 'big five' (lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo) and the incredible spectacle of the annual wildebeest migration.

Day 1: Saturday - Heathrow-Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2: Sunday - Amboseli

Transfer to the Safari Lounge, where you can freshen up and store any additional luggage. Depart for Amboseli (250 km). Afternoon game drive. Overnight: Amboseli Sopa Lodge (lunch and dinner included).

Day 3: Monday - Amboseli

An early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Later take an afternoon game drive. Overnight: Amboseli Sopa Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4: Tuesday - Lake Naivasha

After breakfast drive to Lake Naivasha (350 km). The rest of the day is at leisure. Outdoor activities can be arranged at Naivasha Sopa Lodge (book and pay locally). Overnight: Lake Naivasha Sopa Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5: Wednesday - Masai Mara

Depart early for your journey to the Masai Mara Game Reserve (270 km). Afternoon game drive. Overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6: Thursday - Masai Mara

Enjoy an early morning balloon flight over the Mara, followed by a bubbly bush breakfast (optional extra £275), or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Later, take an afternoon game drive. Overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7: Friday - Extension or Heathrow

Return to Nairobi (300 km), then proceed with your chosen beach extension or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.



GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. Microbuses in Kenya have game viewing hatches (accessible from the rear seats) and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.

For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party. Standard Microbuses are ideal for groups of 5 or more, while Premier Microbuses are more spacious. Four



wheel drive vehicles are available for a supplement and seat up to five or seven passengers (all with window seats) and have game viewing roof hatches.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT FLIGHT OPTIONS



On this safari itinerary, you can cut out the final drive back to Nairobi and fly from the Masai Mara back to Nairobi, for a supplement from £190 per person. Alternatively, fly from the Masai Mara straight to Mombasa for a supplement from £265 per person.

Flights are in light aircraft and the baggage allowance is strictly 15 kg per person. Where possible additional luggage can be left at your hotel or at the Safari Lounge in Nairobi and retrieved after the safari. When flying from the Masai Mara to Mombasa your entire luggage must be restricted to 15 kg as no luggage can be stored in Nairobi.

HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.

NAIROBI SAFARI LOUNGE - UNIQUE

Guests on this itinerary have use of the facilities at the unique 'Safari Lounge' when passing through Nairobi, either before or after the safari (time permitting).

The first of its kind in Kenya, the lounge offers complimentary refreshments and showers plus access to TV. The lounge is located in Nairobi, approximately 10 km from the airport.

This itinerary operates with a maximum of 7 passengers, all guaranteed a window seat. See above for vehicle options. Pack a mixture of warm and light clothing in soft bags plus sunglasses, camera and insect repellent.
