13-night driving safari in Kenya & Tanzania

**NAIROBI • SAMBURU • ABERDARES • LAKE NAKURU • MASAI MARA
ARUSHA • LAKE MANYARA • SERENGETI • NGORONGORO**

This magnificent safari visits key areas of the migration path between the Serengeti and the Masai Mara. All accommodation has been selected for the superb location. You may even be lucky enough to witness one of nature's great events, the great migration.

Day 1: Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2: Nairobi

Transfer to your hotel for a day at leisure or choose from a selection of optional excursions, which can be booked and paid for locally. Overnight: Nairobi Serena Hotel.

Day 3: Samburu

After an early breakfast drive to the Samburu National Reserve (360 km – approximately 6 hours) and check in to your lodge. Lunch. Late afternoon game drive. Overnight: Samburu Simba Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4: Samburu

Morning and late afternoon game drives. Overnight: Samburu Simba Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5: Aberdares

Drive to the slopes of Mount Kenya and check in to Mountain Lodge (240 km – approximately 4 hours). Spend the afternoon viewing game from the lodge, or join an optional nature walk (payable locally and weather permitting) led by a local guide. Overnight: Serena Mountain Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6: Lake Nakuru

After breakfast continue to Lake Nakuru (240 km – approximately 4 hours). Arrive in time for lunch at the lodge, before enjoying an afternoon game drive with possible sightings of rhino. Overnight: Lake Nakuru Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7: Masai Mara

After an early breakfast drive through the Great Rift Valley and into the Masai Mara (370 km – approx 7 hours). Lunch en route to your lodge. Enjoy a late afternoon game drive. Overnight: Mara Serena Safari Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 8: Masai Mara

Enjoy an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge, or an early morning balloon flight over the Mara followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra). Spend the rest of the day relaxing before a late afternoon game drive. Overnight: Mara Serena Safari Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

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Day 9: Arusha

Return to Nairobi by road (360 km – approx 6 hours), then transfer to the airport for an evening flight to Kilimanjaro. Transfer to Serena Mountain Village (approximately 45 minutes), a haven of calm and serenity away from the hustle and bustle of Arusha. Overnight: Serena Mountain Village (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 10: Lake Manyara

After breakfast drive to Lake Manyara National Park, famous for its tree climbing lions (150 km – approximately 2 hours 30 minutes). Your lodge commands panoramic views across the floor of the Great Rift Valley. Here you have time to relax before an afternoon game drive. Overnight: Lake Manyara Serena Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

SERENGETI



Day 11: Serengeti

Drive to the world-famous Serengeti National Park with game viewing en route (235 km – approximately 5 hours). Overnight: Serengeti Serena Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 12: Serengeti

Enjoy an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge, or take an early morning balloon flight over the Serengeti followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra). Later enjoy an afternoon game drive. Overnight: Serengeti Serena Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 13: Ngorongoro Crater

Drive to the Ngorongoro Crater via Olduvai Gorge (200 km – approx 4 hours). Lunch at your lodge which is perched on the jagged rim of the Crater. The afternoon is at leisure. Overnight: Ngorongoro Serena Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 14: Ngorongoro Crater

Drive down into the Crater for a half-day of game viewing. This extinct volcano plays host to wildebeest, zebras, buffaloes, gazelles, elephants rhinos and big cats. Visit a local Masai village (time permitting). Overnight: Ngorongoro Serena Lodge (breakfast lunch and dinner included).

Day 15: Beach or return

Return to Arusha (200 km – approximately 3.5 hours). Lunch at a local restaurant. Transfer to the airport and proceed with your chosen beach extension, or return to Heathrow via Nairobi (breakfast and lunch included).

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ON SAFARI IN TANZANIA AND KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.



YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. Microbuses in Kenya have game viewing hatches (accessible from the rear seats) and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks. In Tanzania you'll switch to a 4-wheel drive vehicle.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.



For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party. In Kenya, standard Microbuses are ideal for groups of 5 or more while Premier Microbuses are more spacious. In Tanzania, Four wheel drive vehicles for your own use are also available - ask for details
