

6-night flying/driving safari in Kenya

AMBOSELI • MASAI MARA OI Kinyei • MASAI MARA Olare Orok

This tour provides a wonderful opportunity to stay in Porini Camps' exclusive accommodation. We combine unforgettable safari experiences, where you are able to walk with Masai warriors and guides whilst you explore the wilderness areas.

Amboseli Porini Camp is set in the Selenkay Conservancy, and is owned and run by the Masai community, which is dedicated to the conservation of wildlife. Mara Porini Camp is set in the exclusive wildlife conservancy of OI Kinyei, one of the most beautiful areas in the region. The conservancy holds a variety of animal species including a pride of lions.

Onto Porini Lion Camp, which is located in the Olare Olok Conservancy, which borders the Masai Mara Game Reserve and is home to an abundance of animals, including big cats.

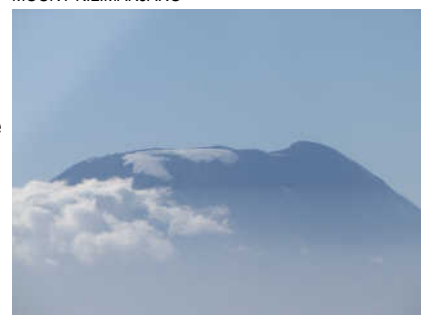
Day 1 - Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2 - Amboseli

Drive to Selenkay Conservancy and to Amboseli Porini Camp (160 km), arriving before lunch. Following afternoon tea, Masai warriors will escort you on a walk to a village to get an insight into their fascinating culture and way of life. Then take a game drive in the conservancy followed by a sundowner at a scenic spot overlooking Kilimanjaro. Night game drive and return to camp. Overnight: Amboseli Porini Camp (lunch and dinner included).

Day 3 - Amboseli

After an early breakfast, drive through the bush on a private track into Amboseli National Park, for a full morning of game viewing. After a picnic lunch, return to Porini Camp later in the afternoon. In the evening enjoy a game drive in Selenkay Conservancy, stopping for a sundowner at a scenic viewpoint, followed by a night game drive to look for nocturnal animals. Return to camp. Overnight: Amboseli Porini Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4 - Masai Mara

After an early breakfast drive through Amboseli Park to the airstrip for your light aircraft flight to Masai Mara via Wilson Airport, Nairobi (change of plane). Met on arrival and transferred to the Camp for lunch. Afternoon game drive, followed by a sundowner and night game drive. Overnight: Mara Porini Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

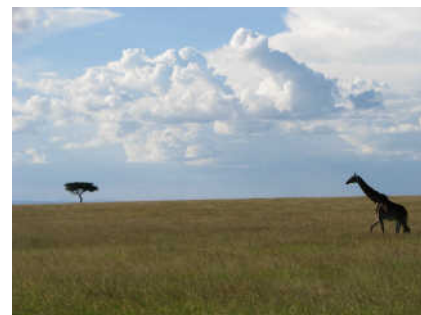
Day 5 - Masai Mara

Optional early morning balloon flight over the Mara – £275. A full day game viewing in the Masai Mara including a picnic lunch. A sundowner and night game drive. Overnight: Mara Porini Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6 - Masai Mara

Morning walk in the conservancy. After breakfast drive across the Mara to Porini Lion Camp in the Olare Orok Conservancy adjacent to the Mara Reserve, arriving before lunch. Afternoon game drive followed by a sundowner. Overnight: Porini Lion Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7 - Masai Mara

Morning and afternoon game drives in the Olare Orok Conservancy. Overnight: Porini Lion Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 8 - Heathrow or Extension

Fly by light aircraft to Nairobi (approx 1 hour). Proceed with your chosen extension or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT FLIGHT OPTIONS



On this safari itinerary, you can fly from the Masai Mara straight to Mombasa for a supplement of £265 per person. There's also an afternoon flight from the Mara to Nairobi at a supplement of £45 per person if you're not continuing to the beach (lunch included on the Masai Mara).

Flights are in light aircraft and the baggage allowance is strictly 15 kg per person. Where possible additional luggage can be left at your hotel or at the Safari Lounge in Nairobi and retrieved after the safari. When flying from the Masai Mara to Mombasa your entire luggage must be restricted to 15 kg as no luggage can be stored in Nairobi.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. This safari operates using 4-wheel drive vehicles accommodating five or seven passengers, and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks. **Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.**



All vehicles have a game viewing roof hatch. For your privacy, you may request the use of an exclusive vehicle for yourself and your party.

HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.

NAIROBI SAFARI LOUNGE – UNIQUE

Guests on this itinerary have use of the facilities at the unique 'Safari Lounge' when passing through Nairobi, either before or after the safari (time permitting).

The first of its kind in Kenya, the lounge offers complimentary refreshments and showers plus access to TV. The lounge is located in Nairobi, approximately 10 km from the airport.

This itinerary operates with a maximum of 7 passengers, all guaranteed a window seat. See above for vehicle options.
