7-night driving / flying safari in Kenya

NAIROBI • OL PEJETA • SAMBURU • MOUNT KENYA • MASAI MARA

A safari of distinction, fit for royalty, visiting Kenya's finest game reserves and enjoying some of Kenya's finest lodges and camps. Travelling by road in your own exclusive safari vehicle, with a light aircraft flight to and from the Masai Mara leaving more time to enjoy the amazing wildlife.

In Samburu, accommodation is in the Ashnil Samburu Camp. In a perfect position on the river bank this a wonderful choice for a stay in Kenya. The camp is home to just 24 luxury tents, all circular, and carefully spread throughout the lush grounds. Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club provides a wonderful base for a short stay with activities including swimming, walking and horse-riding, while the Fairmont Mara Safari Club sits on an ox-bow bend of the River Mara.

Monday - Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2: Nairobi

On arrival transfer to your hotel for a day at leisure. Overnight: Fairmont Norfolk Hotel.

Day 3: Ol Pejeta

After breakfast, depart for the Ol Pejeta Conservancy. (240 km – approximately 4 hours 30 minutes). Arrive in time for lunch before an afternoon game drive and a visit to the Chimpanzee Sanctuary. Overnight: Sweetwaters Tented Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4: Samburu

Depart for the Samburu National Reserve (150 km – approximately 3 hours 30 minutes). Arrive at Ashnil Samburu Camp for lunch. In the afternoon enjoy a game drive. Overnight: Ashnil Samburu Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 5: Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game drives, with time in between to relax and enjoy the beautiful surrounds. Overnight: Ashnil Samburu Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6: Mount Kenya

Drive to the slopes of Mount Kenya (140 km – approximately 3 hours) arriving in time for lunch. The remainder of the day is free to relax and take advantage of the facilities on offer at this superb safari club. Overnight: Mount Kenya Safari Club (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7: Masai Mara Conservancy

Transfer to Nanyuki for your light aircraft flight to the Masai Mara (approximately 1 hour 30 minutes). Enjoy lunch at Mara Safari Club before experiencing an afternoon game drive in the private conservancy, by 4-wheel drive vehicle. Overnight: Fairmont Mara Safari Club (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

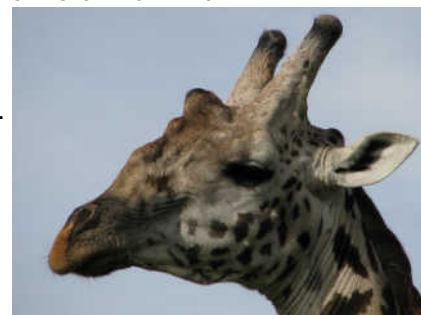
Day 8: Masai Mara Conservancy

An early morning balloon flight over the Mara, followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra), or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the camp. Late afternoon game drive. Game drives are in 4-wheel drive vehicles within the private conservancy. Overnight: Fairmont Mara Safari Club (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9: Extension or Heathrow

Fly in the morning from the Masai Mara by light aircraft to Nairobi (approximately 1 hour). Then proceed with your chosen beach extension, or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.

ON THE ROAD

Safaris often cover long distances on rough and uneven roads and may be dusty or muddy. Drives between game parks and lodges are made at a relatively high speed in order to make the journeys as comfortable as possible. Occasionally vehicles may become stuck in mud or even break down, but help is normally available nearby.



Safari vehicles are not air-conditioned. Approximate distances are given between points on each itinerary, but take these as a guideline only, as travel may take longer than expected due to poor road conditions or unexpected wildlife sightings. Changes to itineraries and camps or lodges are sometimes unavoidable.

LIGHT AIRCRAFT FLIGHT OPTIONS



On this safari itinerary, you can fly from the Masai Mara straight to Mombasa for a supplement of from £155 per person.

Flights are in light aircraft and the baggage allowance is strictly 15 kg per person. Where possible additional luggage can be left at your hotel or at the Safari Lounge in Nairobi and retrieved after the safari. When flying from the Masai Mara to Mombasa your entire luggage must be restricted to 15 kg as no luggage can be stored in Nairobi.

YOUR SAFARI VEHICLE

Safari vehicles are driven by expert driver/guides, who have extensive knowledge of the regions and wildlife. This safari features Premier Microbuses, which have game viewing hatches and are equipped with a cool box for you to store your drinks. The itinerary is offered on a private and exclusive basis with a minimum of two passengers.

Window seat guaranteed on this itinerary.



Game drives on the Masai Mara are conducted in the lodge's own 4x4 vehicles.

HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.

NAIROBI SAFARI LOUNGE – UNIQUE

Guests on this itinerary have use of the facilities at the unique 'Safari Lounge' when passing through Nairobi, either before or after the safari (time permitting).

The first of its kind in Kenya, the lounge offers complimentary refreshments and showers plus access to TV. The lounge is located in Nairobi, approximately 10 km from the airport.

This itinerary operates with a maximum of 7 passengers, all guaranteed a window seat. See above for vehicle options. Pack a mixture of warm and light clothing in soft bags plus sunglasses, camera and insect repellent. Minimum age 8 years.
