7-night flying safari in Kenya

NAIROBI • SAMBURU • GREAT RIFT VALLEY • MASAI MARA

With some of the best game viewing locations in East Africa, Intrepids Camps offer a unique combination of stunning views, superb accommodation, and fantastic game viewing adventures, with expert safari guides and an array of cultural, sporting and family activities. For all departures until 31 December 2010 your stay in Samburu will be at the Ashnil Samburu Camp.

Samburu Intrepids is renowned as a pioneer of luxury camping and is situated on the banks of the Uaso Nyiro River. The acclaimed Adventurers' Club offers a uniquely educational safari experience for children. Perched on the Eburu Escarpment, overlooking the sparkling waters of Lake Naivasha and the sweeping floor of the world's largest valley, the Great Rift Valley Lodge and Golf Resort enjoys incredible views and also offers an Adventurers' Club for children. The Mara camp enjoys one of the most spectacular locations in the Mara and also has an Adventurers' Club for children.

Day 1 - Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2 - Nairobi

On arrival transfer to your hotel for a day at leisure or choose from a selection of optional excursions. Overnight: Nairobi Serena Hotel.

Day 3 - Samburu

Fly to the Samburu National Reserve (approximately 1 hour 15 minutes) and transfer to your lodge for lunch. Samburu Intrepids Club looks out over the riverbank where herds of elephants, buffaloes and zebras come to drink, together with the rarer species of reticulated giraffe, beisa oryx and long-necked gerenuk antelope. A late afternoon game drive. Overnight: Samburu Intrepids (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4 - Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game drives. Overnight: Samburu Intrepids (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

LAKE NAIVASHA



Day 5 - Lake Naivasha

Light aircraft flight to Wilson airport (approximately 1 hour) to connect with the flight to Loldia airstrip (approximately 20 minutes). Transfer to the Great Rift Valley Lodge and Golf Resort at Lake Naivasha for overnight (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 6 - Lake Naivasha

Half-day trip to Lake Nakuru National Park. Leisure activities at the lodge include boating and fishing on Lake Naivasha, tennis, a driving range and an 18-hole golf course (book and pay locally). Overnight: Great Rift Valley Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 7 - Masai Mara

Boat trip on Lake Naivasha. After lunch transfer to the airstrip for a light aircraft flight to the Masai Mara (approximately 45 minutes). An afternoon game drive. Mara Intrepids Camp sits above a sweeping bend in the Talek River. Overnight: Mara Intrepids (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 8 - Masai Mara

An early morning balloon flight, followed by a 'bubbly' bush breakfast (optional extra £275), or an early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the camp. Late afternoon game drive. Overnight: Mara Intrepids (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9 - Extension or Heathrow

Light aircraft flight to Nairobi (approximately 1 hour), then proceed with your chosen extension or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

WHY CHOOSE A FLYING SAFARI?

More and more visitors to East Africa are choosing a 'Flying Safari', which includes internal transfers by air, instead of by road. This option is usually more expensive, but there are many benefits from travelling in this way. Most obviously you can save time travelling between parks and increase time relaxing on holiday and enjoying game drives.

In their own right the light aircraft flights are exhilarating and exciting. Often you are one of only a handful of people in the aircraft flying over the varied African landscapes. Game drives are conducted in 4x4 vehicles.



NAIROBI SAFARI LOUNGE – UNIQUE

Guests on this itinerary have use of the facilities at the unique 'Safari Lounge' when passing through Nairobi, either before or after the safari (time permitting).



The first of its kind in Kenya, the lounge offers complimentary refreshments and showers plus access to TV. The lounge is located in Nairobi, approximately 10 km from the airport.

The most popular option is flying to the Masai Mara Game Reserve. With morning and afternoon flight departures from Nairobi with approximately a 1 hour flight, you can be in the bush to either enjoy a sumptuous lunch, or in time for the late afternoon game drive.

Please bear in mind that all of the itineraries shown can be adapted to suit your personal requirements. Simply contact us for your tailor-made quotation. Luggage allowance on light aircraft is 15 kg per person. Flights may operate via various airstrips en route. Extensions to Mombasa, Lamu, Zanzibar, Seychelles and Mauritius are easily combinable.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
