Combine the majestic views of Kilimanjaro from Amboseli National Park with the beauty of Samburu Game Reserve and the unbeatable wildlife of the Masai Mara - a superb combination.

Day 1 - Daily Heathrow–Nairobi

Fly from Heathrow overnight to Nairobi.

Day 2 - Nairobi

On arrival transfer to your hotel for a day at leisure. Overnight: Ole-Sereni Hotel.

Day 3 - Amboseli

Fly by light aircraft to the Amboseli National Park (45 minutes). Afternoon game drive. Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 4 - Amboseli

Early morning and late afternoon game drives. Overnight: Ol Tukai Lodge (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Days 5-6 - Samburu

Transfer by light aircraft to Nairobi (45 minutes), then connect with the flight to the Samburu Game Reserve (1 hour). Two nights with game drives. Overnight: Ashnil Samburu Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Days 7-8 - Masai Mara

Transfer by light aircraft to the Masai Mara (1 hour 30 minutes). Two nights with game drives and optional balloon flight – £275. Overnight: Ashnil Mara Camp (breakfast, lunch and dinner included).

Day 9 - Extension or Heathrow

Transfer by light aircraft to Nairobi (45 minutes), then proceed with your chosen beach extension or return to Heathrow (breakfast included).

ON SAFARI IN KENYA

The Swahili word 'safari' literally means 'journey'. Today, the word has been adopted throughout Africa to encompass the thrill and excitement of game viewing. East Africa lays claim to some of the world's finest game viewing against a backdrop of diverse and dramatic landscapes.

WHY CHOOSE A FLYING SAFARI?

More and more visitors to East Africa are choosing a 'Flying Safari', which includes internal transfers by air, instead of by road. This option is usually more expensive, but there are many benefits from travelling in this way. Most obviously you can save time travelling between parks and increase time relaxing on holiday and enjoying game drives.

In their own right the light aircraft flights are exhilarating and exciting. Often you are one of only a handful of people in the aircraft flying over the varied African landscapes. Game drives are conducted in 4x4 vehicles.



NAIROBI SAFARI LOUNGE – UNIQUE

Guests on this itinerary have use of the facilities at the unique 'Safari Lounge' when passing through Nairobi, either before or after the safari (time permitting).



The first of its kind in Kenya, the lounge offers complimentary refreshments and showers plus access to TV. The lounge is located in Nairobi, approximately 10 km from the airport.

The most popular option is flying to the Masai Mara Game Reserve. With morning and afternoon flight departures from Nairobi with approximately a 1 hour flight, you can be in the bush to either enjoy a sumptuous lunch, or in time for the late afternoon game drive.

Please bear in mind that all of the itineraries shown can be adapted to suit your personal requirements. Simply contact us for your tailor-made quotation. Luggage allowance on light aircraft is 15 kg per person. Flights may operate via various airstrips en route. Extensions to Mombasa, Lamu, Zanzibar, Seychelles and Mauritius are easily combinable.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST!

Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
