Flexible 3-night flying safari in Kenya **SAMBURU NATIONAL RESERVE**

This is a fantastic service across Kenya and Tanzania and transfers are therefore easy and convenient. These flights take you over incredible terrain and the views can be breathtaking!

Day 1: Depart

Fly overnight from Heathrow to Nairobi.

Day 2: Samburu

Transfer to Wilson airport in Nairobi for a flight by light aircraft (maximum baggage allowance 15 kgs) to Samburu National Reserve (approximately 1 hr 15 minutes). Met on arrival at the airstrip and transferred to your lodge. After lunch at the lodge enjoy a late afternoon game drive. Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp, with a range of other accommodation options available.

Day 3: Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game drives enable you to see wildlife unique to this arid yet beautiful part of Kenya. Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp.

Day 4: Samburu

Early morning and late afternoon game drives. Overnight at Ashnil Samburu Camp.

Day 5: Beach or Return

After breakfast transfer to the airstrip for a flight by light aircraft to Nairobi. Met on arrival and proceed with your chosen option.

ASHNIL SAMBURU CAMP

On safari at Samburu National Park, the Ashnil Samburu Camp is in a perfect

position on the river bank, this brand new camp is a wonderful choice for your stay in Kenya. Set south of Ewaso Nyiro River, in Buffalo Springs Game Reserve, Samburu, a stay here gives you unrivalled access to game viewing.

The waters of the great Ewaso Nyiro River draw wildlife in great numbers to its banks, creating an oasis of green. This is spectacular country, set against a backdrop of the mighty Mount OI Olokwe. Samburu is visited by large herds of elephants, drawn by the promise of water. In the dry season the elephants use their tusks to dig deep into the dry river beds, unearthing precious water.

These waterholes then become a focal point for other game. The Samburu region is the best place to find several endemic northern species, including gerenuk, the reticulated giraffe and Grevy's zebra. The camp is home to just 24 luxury tents, all circular, and carefully spread throughout the lush grounds. A lovely pool is a welcome place to cool off. By day there are guided walks, and to relax there is a massage tent and sundowners are offered at night.

Facilities at the Ashnil Samburu Camp include a restaurant, bar and a verandah deck overlooking the river. Leisure facilities include an outdoor pool, guided nature walks and massage. Accommodation 24 twin/double tents with fan, private shower room, safe and terrace.

The most popular option is flying to the Masai Mara Game Reserve. With morning and afternoon flight departures from Nairobi with approximately a 1 hour flight, you can be in the bush to either enjoy a sumptuous lunch, or in time for the late afternoon game drive.

Luggage allowance on light aircraft is 15 kg per person. Flights may operate via various airstrips en route. Extensions to Mombasa, Lamu, Zanzibar, Seychelles and Mauritius are easily combinable.

GAME DRIVES

A safari guarantees both excitement and the unexpected! This includes close encounters with wild animals, bumpy roads and helping out when the odds are down. Game drives normally take place early morning and evening when the animals are more active, and last between one and two hours. At some lake lodges game drives are not provided, although optional excursions may be purchased locally. Game drives are not included at tree lodges, as they overlook waterholes and salt licks which attract animals during the day and night. It is worth noting that game viewing is not an exact science and sightings of particular species cannot be guaranteed.



HOT AIR BALLOONING - A MUST! Optional Hot Air Ballooning can be arranged on this itinerary, while on the Masai Mara. This exhilarating experience starts at dawn, with around an hour in the air, followed by a Bush breakfast complete with sparkling wine.
